Flexibility in scheduling



DOCUMENTS YOU WILL NEED

OFFICER AFFILIATION

- DD Form 214
- USNR Commission/Oath of Office
- Separation DD Form 2808/2807-1 (HIV Results within last 12 months), DD Form 2697
- Ready Reserve Agreement (NAVPERS 1200/1)

ENLISTED AFFILIATION

- DD Form 214
- Separation DD Form 2808/2807-1 (HIV Results within last 12 months), DD Form 2697
- Copy of Last three Evaluations
- PRIMS printout

RELOCATION FLEXIBILITY

If you relocate, the Navy Reserve has flexibility that may allow for authorized absences of up to six (6) months while you reestablish yourself. They also assist you in transferring to a new drill site located near you.

RESERVE RETIREMENT POINTS


- Members can retire after 20 combined years of active duty and reserve service.
- Retirement income begins at age 60, with qualifying service, for the rest of your life.

05 WITH 20 YEARS

- Current Age: 28
- 6 years Active (Past): $365 \times 6 = 2190$ points
- 14 years Reserve (Future): $78 \times 14 = 1092$ points
- Total points: 3282 (9.12 years or 22.3%)
- Retirement year - 2030, Retirement pay starts 2048
- Retirement pay: \$5658 month / + medical benefits *

* These figures are in "tomorrow's dollars" and have been adjusted to reflect average pay.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

ACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING (ADT)

- Temporary recall opportunities. Can be for 30, 60, 90 days up to 1 year
- Active Duty for Special Work (ADSW)
- Recall opportunities (for up to three (3) year intervals)

MOBILIZATION DEFERMENT

- NAVADMIN 007/07
- Enlisted/Officer Affiliation within 6-months of separation from Active Duty qualifies for 24-month mobilization deferment
- Affiliation between 6 and 12 months from Active Duty qualifies for 12-month mobilization deferment
- NCS and NAT not eligible
